

Dear Surgical Guest,

Welcome to Pine Ridge Surgery Center. Please read the following for important information regarding your surgical procedure.

What to bring:

Please bring your insurance cards
Please bring your photo Identification
Please bring your co-payment
Please bring your negotiated partial
deductible

- A nurse will call you regarding your procedure. The nurse will ask questions about your medications, dosages, medical and surgical history. Based on your medications and history; diagnostic lab tests, Xrays and ECGs may need to be completed prior to your surgery. These are not routinely performed on all surgical patients.
- You will be going home the same day. It is required that someone else drive you home. If you are using
 public transportation to return home, you must have a responsible adult to escort you home. It is
 strongly suggested that you not drive for the remainder of the day, and that someone stay with you
 until the following day.
- Call your surgeon's office if you develop a cold, sore throat, fever or any other illness that occurs within 48 hours before your surgery.

FASTING BEFORE SURGERY:

- **FOOD/WATER:** Fasting instructions will be provided by a nurse from the Surgery Center.
- Your **prescription** medications will be reviewed during the interview and those indicated may be taken with sips of water on the day of surgery.
- No oral hypoglycemic medication or insulin on the day of surgery.
- Please NO gum, breath mints or chewing tobacco after midnight.
- Brush your teeth, rinse and spit without swallowing the water.
- PLEASE take a shower the morning of surgery using an antimicrobial soap such as Dial.

WHAT TO BRING:

Bring payment for co-pay and deductible discussed with the Surgery Center.
Bring your insurance card and photo ID.
Please do NOT apply makeup, deodorant, creams or lotions.
Bring a case for contacts, glasses and dentures.
Bring crutches if having foot surgery.
Bring any durable medical equipment (DME) already issued or previously in use as per
instructed by center personnel or physician (boot, splint, etc).
Leave ALL jewelry and valuables at home. The Surgery Center is not responsible for valuables.
Wear loose fitting, comfortable clothes.
